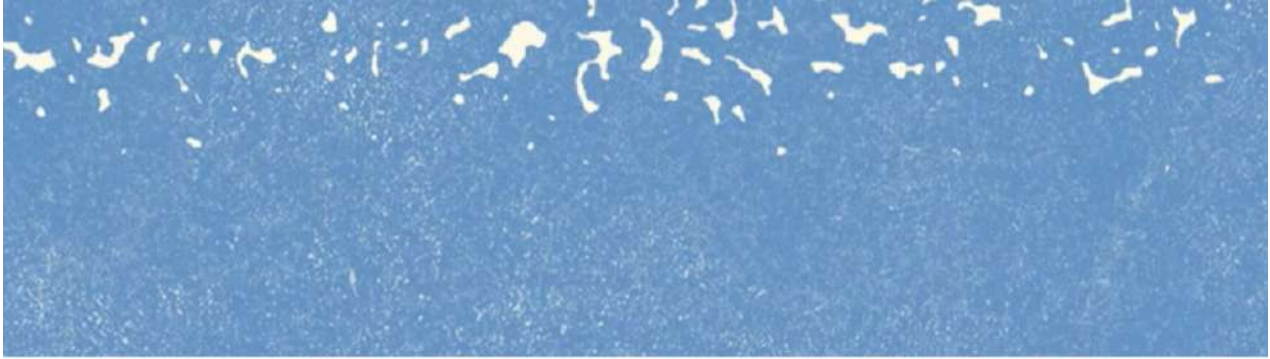

In summer, Ibiza can seem entirely geared toward bright lights, loud music, and congregations of beautiful people. But even then, some corners of the island remain undisturbed and largely undiscovered. Especially in the north, where steep, narrow trails made by fishermen or smugglers rise from isolated coves into a forest domain of birds, pines and wild rosemary. Compared to Majorca or Formentera, there's not much in the way of paving or signposting, and it's more than possible to find absolute peace and quiet en route.
